

Presidential Decree N° 91-342 of September 28, 1991, on the accession to the Treaty on Principles Governing the Activities of States in the Exploration and Use of Outer Space, including the Moon and other Celestial Bodies, opened for signature in London, Moscow and Washington on January 27, 1967

The President of the Republic,

On the basis of the report of the Foreign Affairs Minister,

Having regard to the constitution, in particular its article 74-11°,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Principles Governing the Activities of States in the Exploration and Use of Outer Space, Including the Moon and Other Celestial Bodies, opened for signature in London, Moscow and Washington on January 27, 1967.

Hereby decrees:

Article 1. The People's Democratic Republic of Algeria accedes to the Treaty on the principles governing the activities of states in the exploration and use of outer space, including the moon and other celestial bodies, opened for signature in London, Moscow and Washington on January 27, 1967.

Art. 2. – The present decree as well as the text of the said treaty shall be published in the Official Journal of the People's Democratic Republic of Algeria.
